### **RNC Meeting Highlights:**

- Our Chairwoman wrote an outstanding letter to the Chairmen of The Commission on Presidential Debates, letting them know that our presidential nominee for 2024 will not participate in The Commission on Presidential Debates. This decision was made after the Commission refused to adhere to some very simple requests from the RNC. For example, the RNC requested that a debate not be hosted after early voting has started, and they declined to commit to this. In addition, they refused to agree to “a simple transparent code of conduct to for moderators to include guidelines for appropriate interactions with candidates during the debates.”
- The RNC has raised \$155 million this cycle, and we have outreased every other committee, including the Democratic National Committee!
- The RNC has also opened twenty-one outreach centers in minority communities around the country (including two in the Atlanta area), and we will double that number before November 2022.
- Three cities that are vying to host the 2024 Republican National Convention hosted wonderful evening receptions during our meeting. It will be a hard choice for the Site Selection Committee to choose between the three great cities of Nashville, Milwaukee, and Salt Lake City!
- The RNC has invested in creating the largest faith outreach committee in the history of the RNC, and their number one job is to reach out to faith-based communities of voters across the country.

### **5 Resolutions were passed:**

1. Resolution to Hold Communist China Accountable for Covid-19 Associated Death and Injury to Millions of Americans and Trillions of Dollars in Damages to the United States' Economy
2. Resolution to Formally Censure Liz Cheney and Adam Kinzinger and to No Longer Support Them as Members of the Republican Party

3. Resolution to Reaffirm Our Commitment to the Current Republican Party Platform
4. Resolution to Oppose Non-Citizen Voting in Local, State, and Federal Elections
5. Resolution to Honor the Life of Ann Heuer (she was the National Committeewoman and Chairwoman in D.C. from 1984-2000)
